Taleseddel til ministerens brug til møde med Orica torsdag d. 3. juni

I would like to welcome all of you. I hope you have had a nice journey.

I have with me today Marianne Thyrring, my Permanent Secretary and Anne-Marie Rasmussen Vice Director of the Danish Environmental Protection Agency.

This is a very special case – both for you and for us. I know that you and your company have made a huge effort to prevent any environmental damage at the facility in Botany Bay.

For us this case is special as it is the first time another OECD country has made this kind of request.

First of all I would like to say that it is important for me in that respect I understood from the EPA, that your company when meeting with them expressed a request to meet me with me before a decision was taken regarding the request from the Australian Ministry of Environment to look at and consider all aspects of the case before making the final decision.

I have been thoroughly briefed by the EPA regarding the background of this case and the situation in Australia but I'm very interested in your assessment of the crucial elements in this case.

I will take your information into consideration and expect to make a final decision very soon.

In my opinion - and that is from a political point of view - a country like Australia is to be in a position to acquire the technical capacity and the necessary facilities in order to dispose of HCB waste in question.

Furthermore, the shipment of such quantities of highly toxic waste transported from one side of the earth to the other poses a risk to the environment should an accident occur, which I don't think is acceptable, all things considered.

Beredskab – Could you please explain us your doubts in this case?

I wish to get your views directly in this case before I make a decision, to make sure that all aspects will be carefully considered in my assessment.
