Please find attached the preliminary draft programme of the meeting, and the general information document.

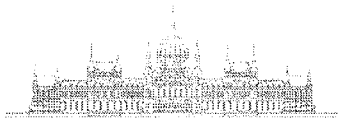

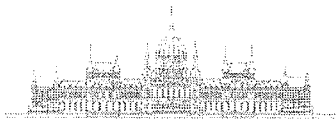
