## UDENRIGSMINISTERIET

### Spørgsmål nr. 62:

I GRU alm. del - bilag 23 skriver Udenrigsministeriet, at der i 2013-aftalen er krav om, at kontraktthaveren ikke må være et udenlandsk ejet datterselskab. Ministeren bedes redegøre for, hvor i udbudsmaterialet det fremgår, at der ikke må være tale om et udenlandsk ejet selskab.

### Svar:

Der er som bekendt tale om et amerikansk udbud, der følger amerikanske udbudsregler og amerikanske udbudsbetingelser. Det kan dog oplyses, at udbudsbetingelserne (Request for Proposals, rfp) fra amerikansk side er offentliggjort på hjemmesiden [www.fedbizopps.gov](http://www.fedbizopps.gov) (se særligt:

#### ”L-3. OFFEROR ELIGIBILITY

Participation in this acquisition is limited to Danish/Greenlandic enterprises. Enterprises must possess a corporation certificate (Selskabscertifikat m. oblat) verifying the company is registered as a business in the Kingdom of Denmark (Det Central Virksomhedsregister (CVR); Det Grønlandske Erhvervsregister (GER); Skráseting Føroya (Skrás. Nr.)).

NOTE: THE REGISTERED OFFICE OF THE ENTERPRISE SHALL BE IN THE KINGDOM OF DENMARK AND SHALL NOT BE REGISTERED AS A SUBSIDIARY OF FOREIGN COMPANY.

Enterprises must produce a signed letter from an officer of a bank within the Kingdom of Denmark verifying the company conducts business with that institution.

NOTE: ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER OF INVOICE PAYMENTS WILL ONLY BE MADE TO A BANK IN THE KINGDOM OF DENMARK.”
