Public Rejection, Violence and Misdemeanour during and after the Farcical Dummy Election held on 7th January, 2024: Part II


In national and international media, the news of the farcical 7th January election held by the fascists Awami League regime in Bangladesh and the many discrepancies around it are flooding at the moment. This is our second report of the day to record the reported cases of violence, misdemeanours, and public rejection of the dummy election all across Bangladesh.

<u>1. An Election of Discrepancies:</u>

Cases of openly bribing voters, giving seals in front of agents, agents from non-Awami candidates shoved out of the centre, ballots sealed at night and snatching away ballots became very common since last night. Also fake agents and agents who has absolutely no knowledge about their candidates were also revealed through media reports. The model of vote rigging and many misdemeanours around that has changed over the course of time after lunch.

When the turnout rate at 3 PM was announced to be only 27.5%, the presiding officers and their subordinates were forced to stamp as many ballots as they can and stuff the ballot boxes. That is why, while official app (available for downloading in mobiles) of the Election Commission showed only 28% vote casted till 4 PM, the Chief Election Commissioner announced an unbelievable statistics of 40%. While many Presiding officers and Assistant Presiding Officers of the poll centres obeyed their orders to stuff ballots during the last hours and also sign off the result sheets before the voting ended, some of them protested and made public statements through social media and news media about such discrepancies.

News reports and social media contents also revealed a uniquely disturbing fact about this dummy election. In many of the poll centres, the authority let a good number of infants and underage children to stamp some ballot papers and counted them as legal votes. This created a large flow of criticism against the fascist regime and their docile election commission in the online media and social networks.

Children were seen to cast votes in many of the poll centres as adults mostly boycotted the election

Also, throughout the day, many independent and Jatiya Party candidates have withdrawn their candidacy from this farcical election and accused the incumbent fascist regime of vote rigging. Some of them even expressed their solidarity with BNP and other pro-democratic parties in boycotting the dummy election. GM Quader (President, Jatiya Party) have accused the fascist Awami League regime of orchestrating another robbing of election.

And even though fake lines were seen to the created in front of the polling centres where foreign observers were scheduled to visit, those people were seen to quickly disburse right after the observers left the vicinity. Even after such "efforts" made by the fascist regime, many observers felt that the election was truly a sham, and a British observer said that he found a North Korea model of democracy in this county.

Many news reports and social media posts evidence such incidents that are being commonly carried out in favour of the candidates.

2. Empty poll centres and Over-exaggerated Turnout Rates:

From the early morning till the closing of voting at 4 PM on 7th January, 2024, most of the poll centres were seen to be almost empty or fully empty. Animals and playful children were seen to be running through the poll centres without any hindrances.

As stated above, It was announced by Election Commission Secretary Jahangir Alam before 1 PM that about 18.5% voters turned out and before 3 PM it rose to 27.15%; but yet, at the end of the voting period, Chief Election Commissioner most unbelievably announced that 40% votes were casted in the election!

Though the Election Commission was wantonly declaring the turnout rates, the independent observers and journalists who visited many poll centres marked such statistics as "completely unbelievable". Media reports also revealed that in all the poll centres, Presiding Officers were forced to sign on the Result Sheet before the voting was even closed. That explains a part of the discrepancy that took place for showing such ridiculous farcical statistics.

Also, it is important to mention that there are about 120 million voters across Bangladesh. 40% of that number stands at 48 million people. Now as there are about 43,000 poll centres across the country, the voter turnout rate per poll centre must be at least 1,116 and each poll centre on average must have a turnout of 140 voters per hour to reach the figure of 40% of the total voters. But the scenes that were seen during the voting time makes it unbelievable that such figure could be reached by the ballot cast during the votes even if all the children and animals present at the empty poll centres could stamp two ballots each!

We have collected a huge number of news reports, photos and videos as evidence to those facts. It is not practically possible to show all of these and so we are only sharing some of those in the following part of this report. Photos of empty polling centres run over by animals:

3. <u>Continuous violence on the Election Day:</u>

From early midnight before the 7th January, 2024, news media and social media platforms were flooded with cases of extreme violence and infighting between the local fascist Awami League goons and the workers of the so-called independent candidates- almost all of them are from Awami League too.

On 7th January, 2024 at around 12:30 PM, at least 2 people were shot in Chattogram in a clash between activists of Awami League nominated candidate Mohiuddin Bachchu and independent candidate Mohammad Manjur Alam, later the police identified the shooter to be Shamim Azad, a follower of Chattogram City Corporation Councillor Wasim Uddin (Vice president, Chattogram Metropolitan Jubo League).

Also, news reports confirm that children were injured by explosion of crude bombs, journalists and women were beaten by violent AL activists, crude bombs were blasted here and there, houses of general people were attacked and vandalised, violent mob clashes happened throughout the day amid rigging of voting process in many of the constituencies.

When the time of the polls was nearing to the conclude, the fascist Awami League goons were acting more aggressive to "capture" the polling centres and cast fake votes and stamped a huge number of ballots and that has caused significant hue and cry in many of the constituencies.
