

- 10. **Recognizing** that the Afghan government cannot do this without large-scale international assistance over a period of years;
- 11. Further recognizing that the Alliance has to a large extent staked its credibility on the success of this mission;
- 12. **URGES** member governments and parliaments of the North Atlantic Alliance to make a long-term commitment to the stabilization of Afghanistan by;
- a. committing a larger and more mobile force to Afghanistan for at least one year;
- b. working with the Afghan government to identify and bring under control the regional warlords who threaten the viability of the nation;
- c. actively supporting efforts to reduce heroin production and trafficking in Afghanistan.
