MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

Mr van der Linden, President of the Assembly, took the Chair at 10.05 a.m.

1. ATTENDANCE REGISTER

The names of the Representatives, Substitutes and Observers who signed the attendance register are given in the Appendix.

2. ELECTIONS OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE COMMISSIONER FOR HUMAN RIGHTS AND THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY

The President announced that he had received the names of three candidates for the election of the Council of Europe Commissioner for Human Rights: Mr Thomas Hammarberg, Mr Marek Antoni Nowicki and Mr Marc Verwilghen. Biographical details of the candidates were contained in Doc. 10661.

The President announced that he had received the name of one candidate for the position of Secretary General of the Parliamentary Assembly: Mr Mateo Sorinas Balfegó. Biographical details of the candidate were contained in Doc. 10656.

The elections would be held between 10 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. Mr Lachnit and Lord Russell-Johnston were chosen by lot as tellers for both elections.

The Assembly proceeded to vote by secret ballot.
