

- **Economy:** Cities account for 85% of the EU's GDP: Europe's competitiveness in the world depends on the leading edge industries and knowledge base in cities.

- **Inclusion:** 75% of Europe's population lives in cities: Europe's cohesion depends on cities' capacity to manage social inclusion and promote integration.

- **Climate:** Cities account for 80% of energy use: Europe won't reach its climate targets without supporting city governments to manage down their carbon footprint.
