Protest mod jævnlige henrettelser af kurdere og andre politiske fanger i Iran

Den Iranske Islamiske republik har i 35 år brugt sin umenneskelige magt til at, arrestere, torturere, deportere, dræbe og henrette mænd og kvinder eller rettere sagt mennesker i alle aldre. I 35 år har hundrede af tusinder af mennesker været utsat for grusomheder fra regimets side. Likvideringer og henrettelser af regimets modstandere er blevet en daglig rutine for det iranske præstestyre. I de sidste 35 år har alle mindretal i Iran, især det kurdiske folk lidt under regimets umenneskelige pres og assimilations politik. Selv om alle regimets modstandere bliver undertrykt, mærker det kurdiske folk i Iran dette pres og disse umenneskelige forhold mere massivt i dagligdagen. Præstestyret har i de sidste tre årtier brugt alle midler for at assimilere og ødelægge den kurdiske kultur og at fjerne eksistensen af kurdere i Iran. Som valgløfte lovede den nye regering mere demokrati, bedre vilkår og større tolerance for mindretallene i Iran. I løbet af de hundrede første dage ved magten, er mere end 300 mennesker blevet arresteret, firs mennesker er blevet henrettet og over hundrede venter på at blive henrettet. Det er typisk menneskerettighedsaktivister og dem der protesterer i mod regimet der bliver anholdt og beskyldt for narkosmugling. Dette er for at dække over modstanden mod regimet og undertrykkelsen af minoriteter i Iran. Den ny regering i Iran har etableret kontakt til vestlige lande især til USA. Denne dialog har desværre ikke gavnnet de Iranske befolkninger.

Regimet har henrettet mange flere og undertrykkelsen er blevet mere massiv. Henrettelsen af 16 baluchere på en gang, samt henrettelse af mange kurdiske journalister, aktivister og andre politiske fanger rundt om i landet, har udløst en række protester fra statslige og humanitære organisationer verden over. Vi håber de danske statslige og humanitære organisationer viser deres utilfredshed modhenrettelserne og undertrykkelsen af hele befolkningsgrupper i Iran. Det Iranske præstestyre vil ikke respektere menneske rettigheder. Præstestyret har dannet en jernring omkring forskellige befolkningsgrupper i Iran. Det iranske folk har brug for støtte og solidaritet fra verdenssamfundets side.

Protest against regular executions of Kurds and other political prisoners in Iran.

The Iranian Islamic republic has for 35 years used its inhuman power to arrest, torture, deport, kill and execute men and women or rather human beings of all ages. For 35 years hundreds of thousand people have suffered the cruelty of the regime. Assassinations and executions of the opponents of the regime, has become a daily routine for the Iranian theocracy. During the last 35 years all minorities in Iran, especially the Kurdish people have suffered the inhuman pressure of an inhuman assimilation policy, carried out by the regime. Even if all the opponents of the regime are being suppressed, the Kurds of Iran feels this pressure and these inhuman conditions even more in their everyday lives. The theocracy has, during the past three decades used all possible means to assimilate and destroy the Kurdish culture and to eliminate the existence of Kurds in Iran. During the election campaign the new government promised more democracy, better conditions and a

greater tolerance towards the minorities of Iran. However, during the first hundred days in power, more than 300 persons have been arrested. Eighty persons have been executed and more than a hundred persons awaits their execution. Mostly, human rights activists and those who object to the regime, are being arrested and accused of drug smuggling. These accusations are a cover-up. The regime is covering up the suppression of minorities in Iran, by calling all opponents drug smugglers. The new government of Iran have established contact to the western countries, especially the USA. This dialogue has unfortunately not been beneficial to the Iranian people. The regime has executed a lot more and the suppression has increased massively. The execution of 16 Baluchees at one time and the execution of many Kurdish journalists, activists and other political prisoners around the country have triggered a series of protests from governmental and humanitarian organizations from all over the world. It is our hope that Danish governmental and humanitarian organizations will show their dissatisfaction towards the executions and suppression of entire populations of Iran. The Iranian theocracy does not and has no intention to respect human rights. The theocracy has created an iron wall around the various populations of Iran. The Iranian people desperately need the support and solidarity of the world society.
