Members of parliaments from all around the world have joined and supported IPCNKR for the purpose of promoting and protecting the human rights of North Koreans in compliance with the principles of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. Since its founding in 2003, IPCNKR has held its annual General Meeting. This year, the 13<sup>th</sup> anniversary General Meeting is scheduled to be held in **Seoul**, **Korea from the 29<sup>th</sup> through the 31<sup>st</sup> of August, 2016**.

The violation of human rights in North Korea is an issue which has been quite persistent over the past several decades. On March 2, 2016, National Assembly of Republic of Korea passed "The North Korean Human Rights Act" which will be in full effect on September 4, 2016. There is a lack of international and political attention and supports for North Korean refugees and those who are held hostage by North Korean government. During our general meeting, we would like to open a discussion addressing such issues, and propose ways to make better such situation.

We sincerely hope that you will be able to join us and recommend honorable members of parliament who are interested in the issues related to human rights of North Koreans. Please confirm your delegates who will be attending the conference by the date of **25 July**, **2016**.

We will be delighted to arrange and provide **two nights** of accommodation during the course of conference between the **29**<sup>th</sup> and **31**<sup>st</sup> of August for **up to three to maximum of five** delegates representing each parliament. Please note that IPCNKR will <u>not</u> be able to fund the airfare for any invitees.
