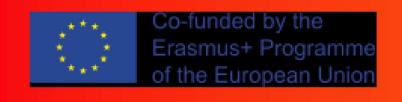

- To provide educational tools, available on the website heroesoffootball.eu





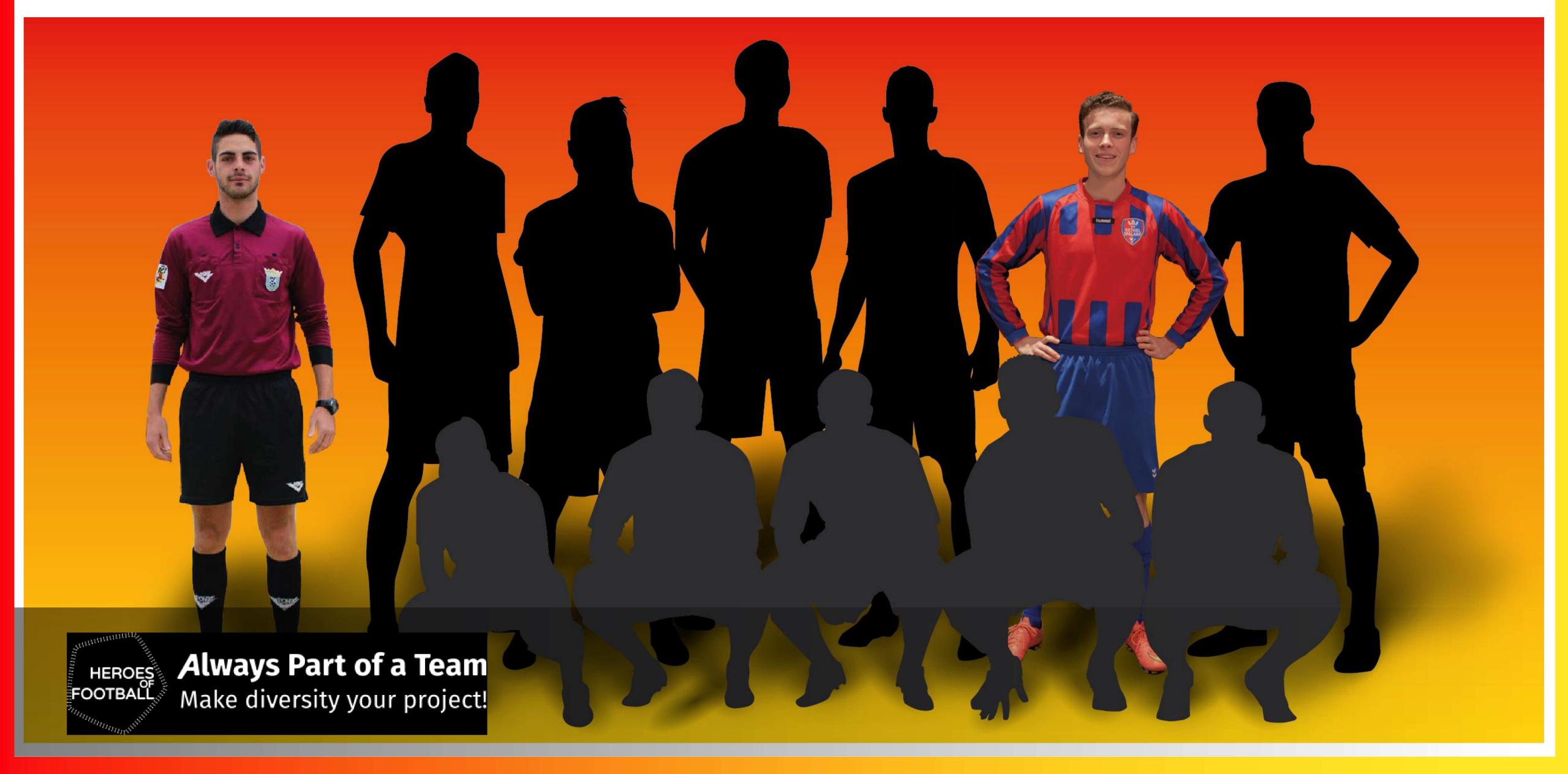














European impact:

- Support from European Football Associations and clubs







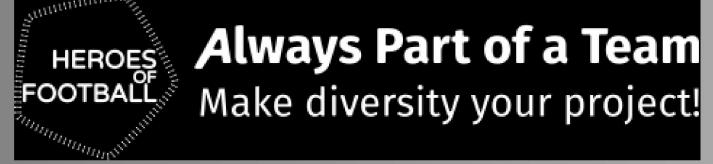


2 Virtual Reality Experience

- To use for workshops at Football Federations and Clubs.





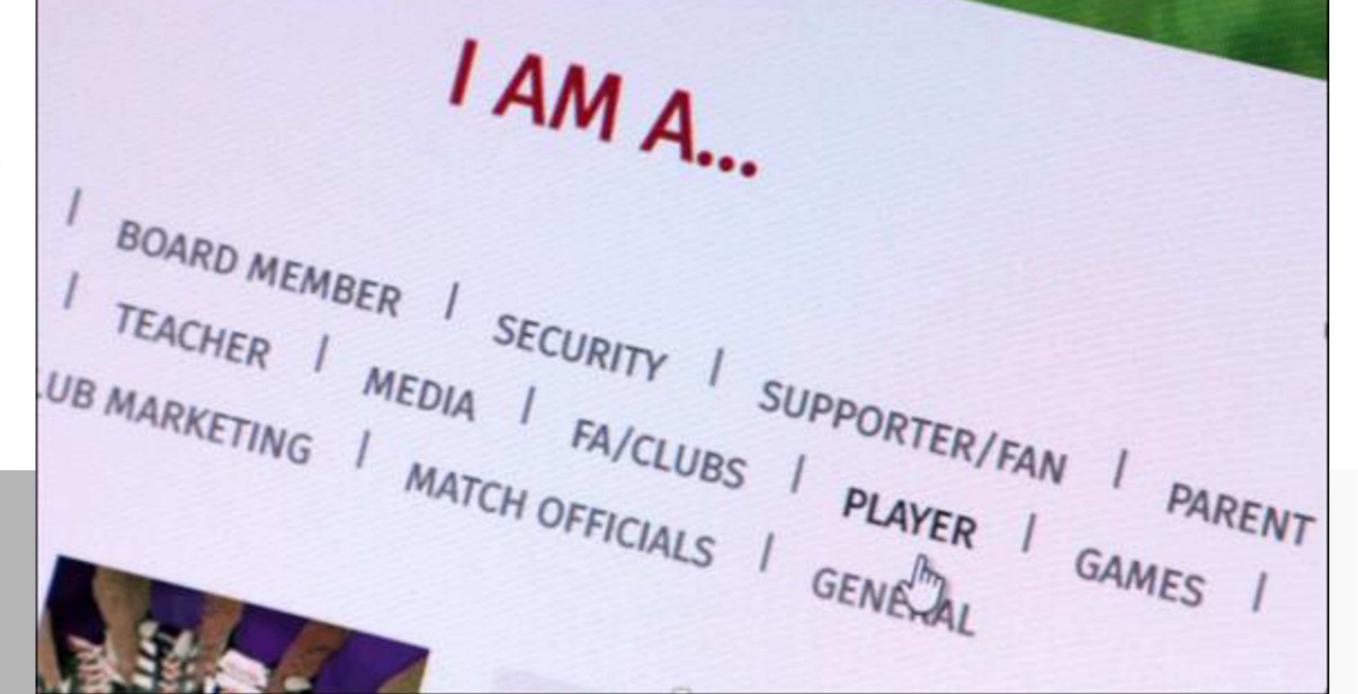




European impact:

 - Is Europe ready for the first professional gay football player to come out of the closet.













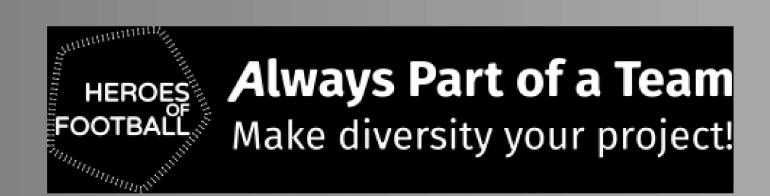






We played a good match this year, but we still have a long way to go -

- We need role models in the world of football who are openly gay.





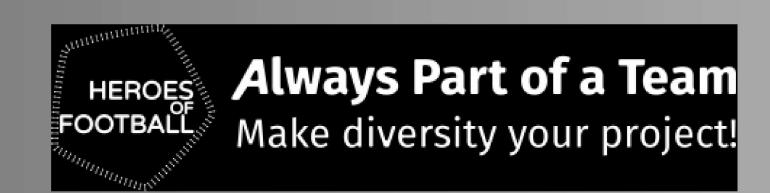






The future of Heroes of Football

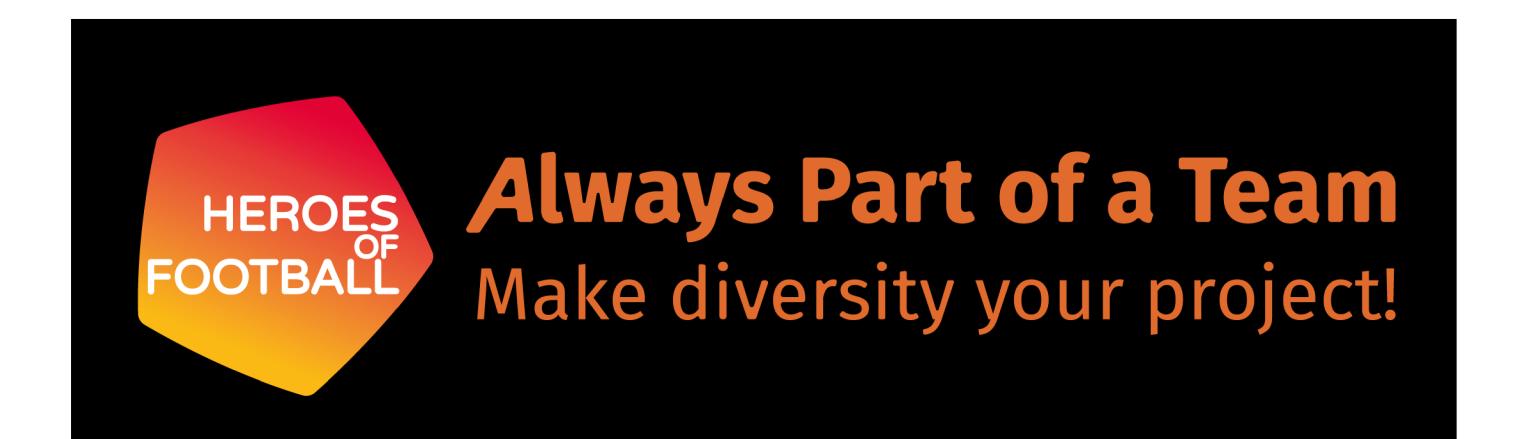
