 Diagnosed with diabetes type 1 at age 1,5 years





This is Klara!

- When the rest of us suddenly can decide to take a weekend abroad, just bringing our passport and a credit card, Klara – as a diabetic patient could do the same, but the situation would be totally different.
- Klara would have had to plan and plan again – to be sure she had everything she needed of medication, medical equipment and necessary patient data, just in case something should happen abroad.
- The reason for this is that when she crosses the borders, her medical history does not follow.
- It does not have to be like that!

We are starting with Alva...




