As mentioned in yesterday's MMM, please find enclosed the motion adopted in the plenary session of the Luxembourg Chamber of Deputies last Thursday (24 February) in its original version (FR).

Please find a courtesy translation below:

„Call on the Government to strongly condemn the unprovoked and unjustified attack on Ukraine by the Russian Federation“

The Chamber of Deputies

- considering the military operations launched by the Russian Federation on Ukrainian territory on 24th February 2022 ;
- considering the recognition of the independence of the Luhansk and Donetsk Republics by the Russian Federation, which puts a de facto end to the Minsk agreements ;
- considering the diplomatic efforts put into motion regarding the conflict between Ukraine and Russia over the past days and weeks ;

calls on the Government :

- to strongly condemn the unprovoked and unjustified attack on Ukraine by the Russian Federation, which constitutes a flagrant violation of international law ;
- to demand that the Russian Federation immediately cease its military operations and withdraw its forces from Ukrainian territory
- to call on the Russian Federation to resolve this conflict peacefully;
- to call for solidarity with Ukraine at the level of the European Union, which should speak in unison concerning this flagrant violation of international law.

MOTION

La Chambre des Député-e-s,

- Considérant les opérations militaires lancées par la Fédération de Russie sur le territoire ukrainien le 24 février 2022 ;
- Considérant la reconnaissance de l'indépendance des républiques de Lougansk et Donetsk par la Fédération de Russie qui met ainsi fin de facto à l'accord de Minsk ;
- Considérant le déploiement d'efforts diplomatiques concernant le conflit entre l'Ukraine et la Russie de ces derniers jours et semaines ;

invite le Gouvernement à :

- à condamner fermement l'attaque non-provoquée et injustifiée de l'Ukraine par la Fédération de Russie qui constitue une violation flagrante du droit international ;
- à exiger de la Fédération de Russie de mettre fin immédiatement à ses opérations militaires et de retirer ses forces du territoire ukrainien ;
- à appeler la Fédération de Russie à résoudre ce conflit de manière pacifique ;
- à appeler à la solidarité avec l'Ukraine au niveau de l'Union européenne qui devra parler d'une seule voix face à cette violation éclatante du droit international.
