- appreciates that the Government of the Czech Republic has strongly and promptly condemned the aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine;
- calls on the Government of the Czech Republic to continue its efforts in support of Ukraine, both bilaterally and within the EU, NATO, and other international organisations;
- calls on the Russian Federation to immediately stop its military aggression against Ukraine.
