## Dear Member of the Parliamentary Assembly,

After two years meeting remotely, the days we worked and spent together in Birmingham were an important momentum for all of us and, more crucially, for our organisation. There was a strong need to work together in such a critical time following the aggression against Ukraine. Now it is time, after two years of pandemia and this first "normalized" session in the UK, to get back to normal and continue working "on site" in Sofia, Vienna and Vancouver.

With this letter I would like, first and foremost, to thank all Members of the OSCE PA for their support in my election as a Vicepresident of the Assembly and also congratulate all other elected colleagues. I feel very honoured and proud to serve as a key voice of democracy, cooperation and security in the OSCE region. And I am also very grateful for representing my delegation in the Parlamentary Assembly.

After more than four years as Head of the Spanish Delegation and one year as Chair of the Second Committee, it is time now for more responsabilities in the Assembly.
