Consultation response; Commission staff working document (SWD) on Scenarios for the transition pathway for a resilient, greener and more digital construction ecosystem

The Danish government welcomes the Commission's work for the transition pathway for a resilient, greener and more digital construction ecosystem and appreciates the opportunity to respond to the consultation of the SWD.

From a Danish perspective, we would like to underline the importance of the revision of the Construction Products Regulation to provide a regulatory framework to communicate and declare environmental performances of construction products in a harmonized and standardized manner.
