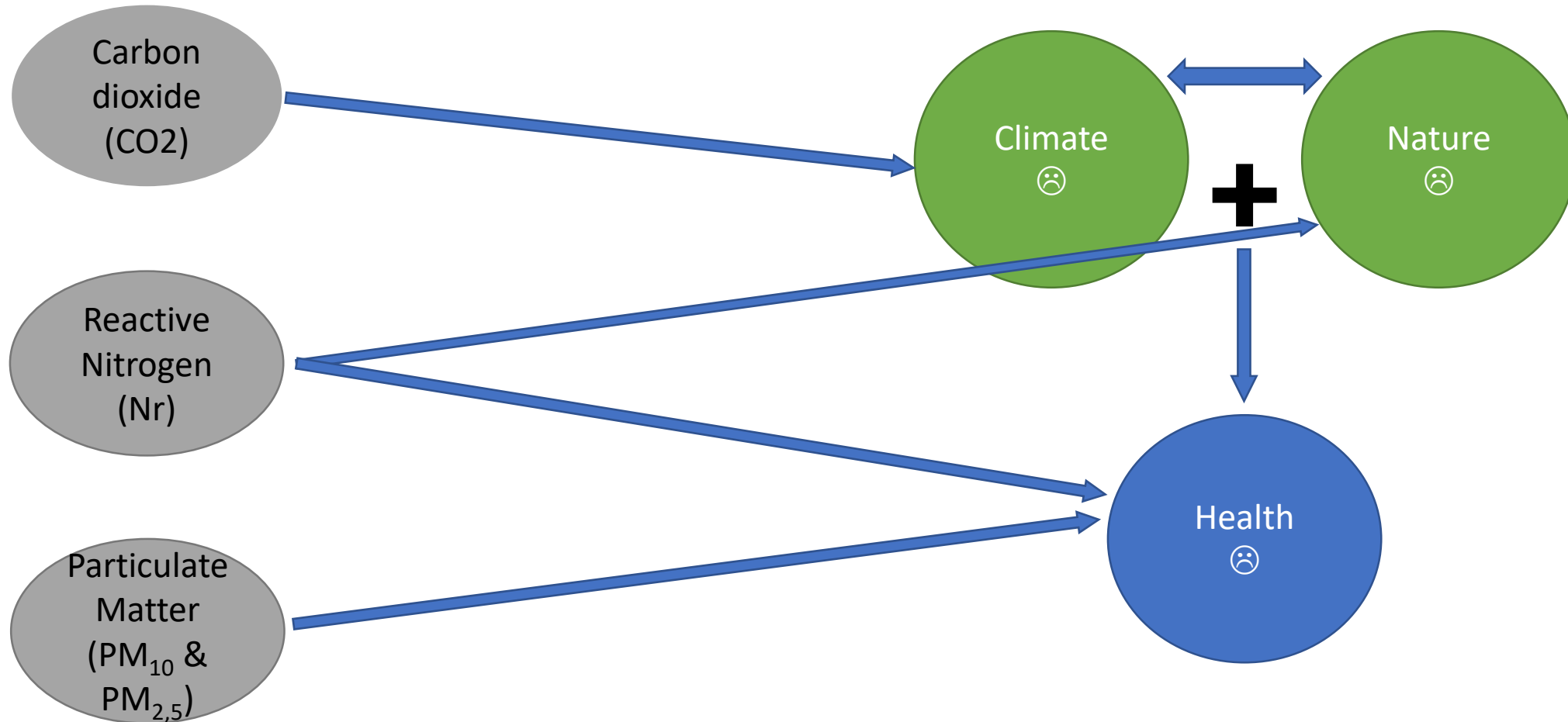

Background

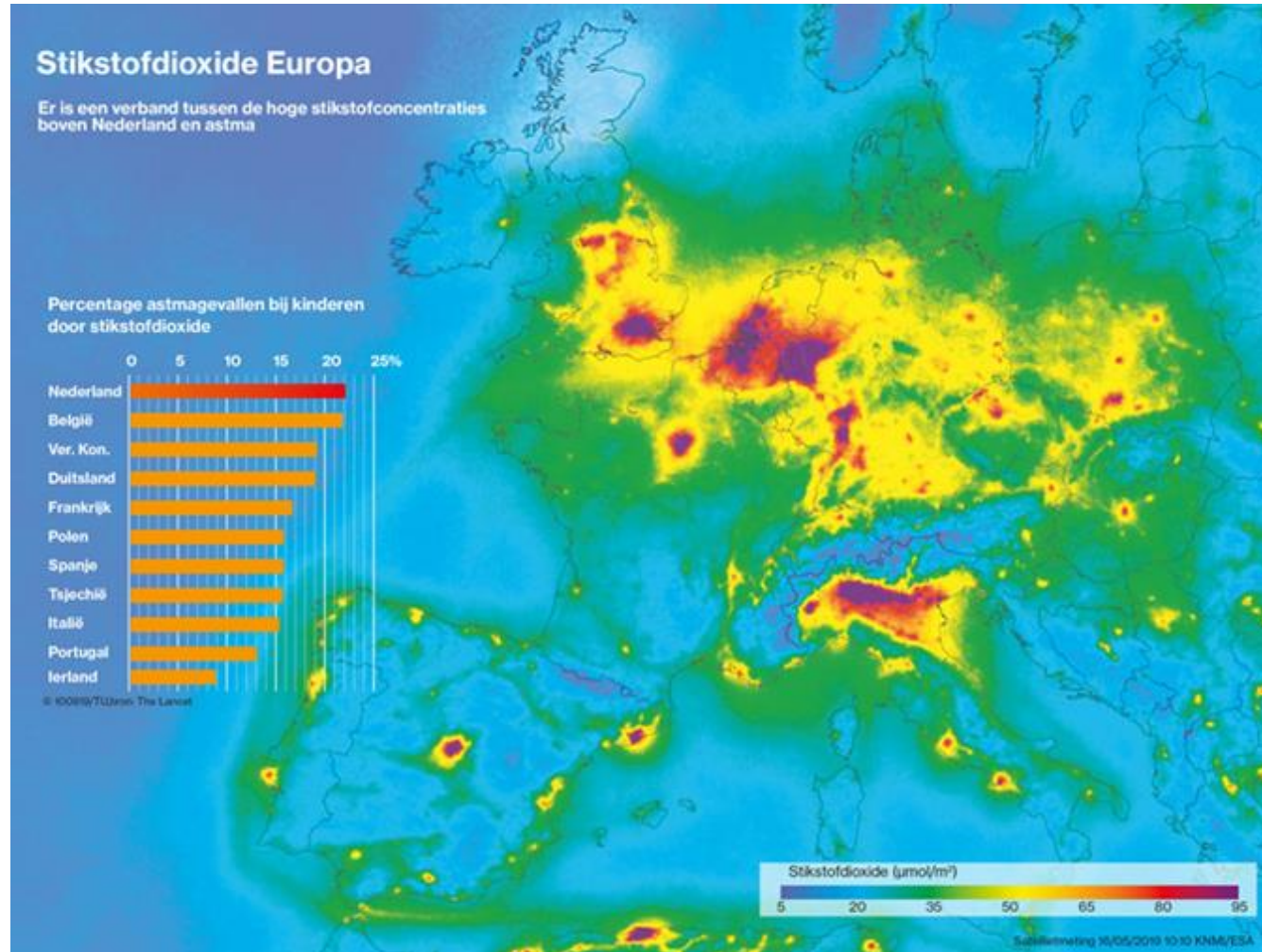
- Dutch National Climate Agreement (2019): 30-40 cities to have a ZEZ by 2025

De zero-emissiezone voor bestel- en vrachtauto's ligt aan de binnenkant van de Centrumring. Bestel- en vrachtauto's die nog niet voldoen aan de zero-emissieregels mogen wel over de Centrumring (S100) en het Telderstracé (S200) en S103 rijden. Het Haaglanden Medisch Centrum (HMC) Westeinde valt buiten de zero-emissiezone.

- Expansion towards the Coastal-area in 2026

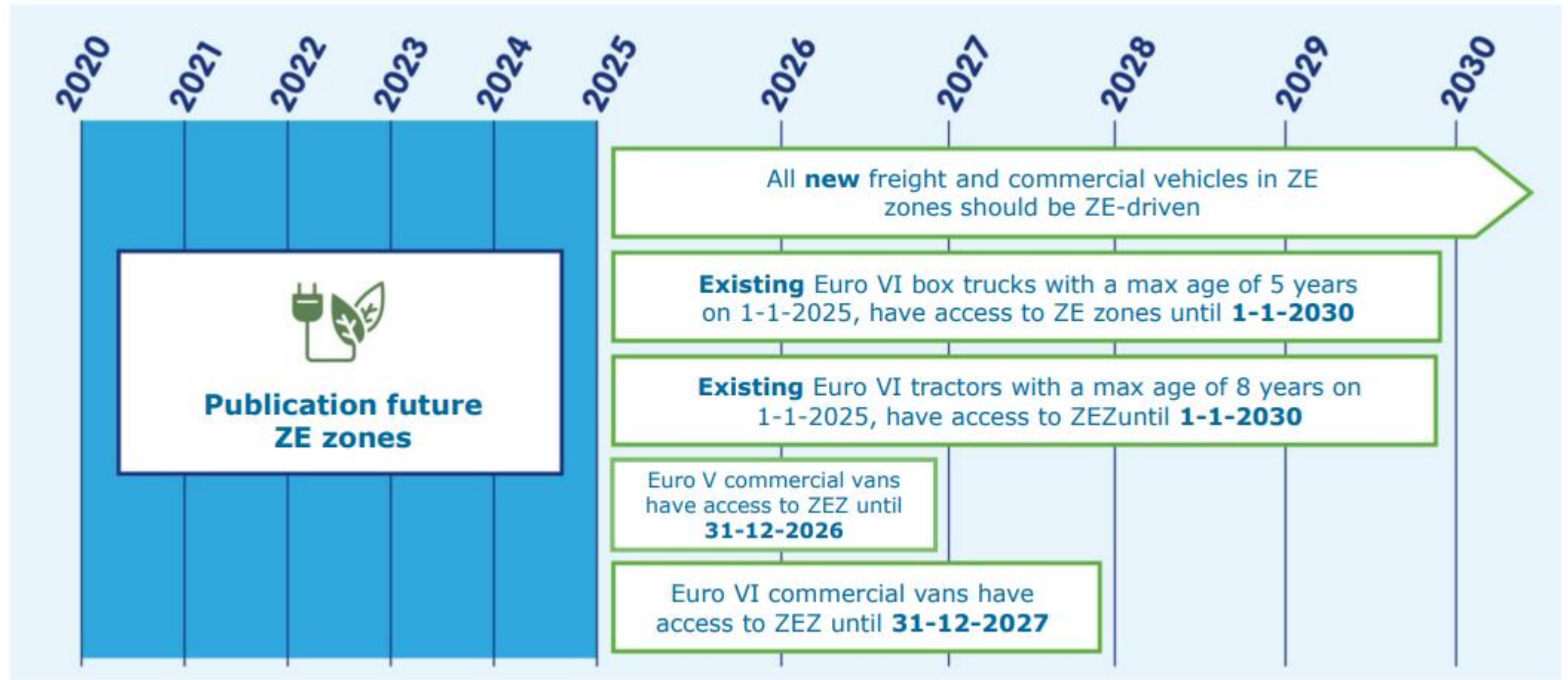


Enforcement
