1. Access to the Venue

- Entry formalities: Each visitor must present one of the following valid documents:
 - National identity card
 - Passport
 - Driver's licence (issued after September 2013)
 - Valid residence permit

⚠ Please ensure that the information provided during registration (names, dates of birth, spelling) matches exactly the ID shown on the day. Any discrepancy will prevent entry.

- Journalists: Admitted under the same conditions as participants (must register, with valid ID).
- Security check: Allow extra time for security procedures.
- The building is accessible for people with reduced mobility (PMR). Access point: 9 Rue de Bourgogne.

Nearest metro stations:

- *Invalides* (Lines 8 & 13, RER C) – 7 min walk

- *Musée Rodin* – dedicated to the works of sculptor Auguste Rodin.
